Waste bin systems

■ Residual waste bins: for non-recyclable waste

Organic bins:

for all kitchen and garden waste, no compostable plastic bags

■ Green paper bin:

for paper and cardboard

■ Blue glass bin or basket:

for glass packaging

Yellow LVP bin:

for lightweight packaging (LVP) made of plastic, metal and composites

The collection schedule only applies to bins up to 240 litres. The emptying dates for 660 and 1100 litre bins can be found on the Internet at www.entsorgung-regional.de.

Provision of the waste bins

Clearly from 6.00 a.m. at the roadside, with lid opening to the street and closed; rubbish bags etc. are not taken away. If the bin has not been emptied on the usual day, it will usually be emptied the next day. Please leave the bin provided. The maximum filling weight of a waste bin must not exceed 200 kilograms per cubic metre. Cardboard boxes, bags, etc. placed next to the bins will not be taken away.

Waste separation

It is compulsory to separate used materials, organic waste and residual waste. The organic waste bin can only be dispensed with if all organic waste produced is composted by the customer.

Ordering, collection and exchange of containers:

Exchange of residual waste and organic waste bins: 23.00 € per plot. All bins damaged by wear and tear will be replaced free of charge.

Garbage fees

They consist of an emptying amount (number of empties) and an annual amount (see table on the right). Paper, glass and household waste bins are free of charge. A microchip records the frequency with which the residual waste and organic waste bins are emptied.

Bulky waste disposal

Bulky waste is bulky waste without recyc-lable components that does not fit into the household waste bin; e.g. armchairs, sofas, mattresses, furniture, carpets, but not waste from building renovations and household liquidations.

Useable items can also be given away or exchanged via the bulky waste exchange at www.entsorgunq-regional.de.

Self-delivery

at all 11 recycling yards in the Enzkreis: per cubic metre or part thereof: € 7.00 maximum 3 m³ per week and delivery.

Collection on request up to 3 m³ for a fee of € 65.00 per collection on two fixed dates per year (dates in the calendar section); request (only in writing) at least ten days before collection with a disposal cheque, which is available at all town halls or request on the Internet at www.entsorgung-regional.de.

Disposal of electrical appliances

Free delivery only at the Hamberg waste disposal centre in Maulbronn

- Large electrical appliances (edge length greater than 50 cm) such as washing machines, dishwashers, dryers, electric cookers, refrigerators, electric radiators, air conditioning units
- Screens e. g. TV sets and computer monitors
- Fluorescent tubes and energy-saving lamps

Free delivery to all recycling centres

 Small electrical appliances without screens (edge length less than 50 cm), e. g. vacuum cleaners, ironing equipment, toasters, deep fryers, clocks, blenders, computers, radios, fax machines, telephones, mobile phones.

Collection on demand

Against reimbursement of the proportional transport costs per item: $20 \, \varepsilon$ for solarium, freezer, special object, $10 \, \varepsilon$ for large electrical appliances, $8 \, \varepsilon$ for monitors (payment at the town hall), the appliances are collected directly from the property on 11 collection dates. To the registration appropriate disposal cheques are available in the city halls. In winter, there may be delays in collection due to traffic. The customers concerned will be informed in good time about an alternative date.

Pollutant disposal from households

Twice a year, pollutants from households (e. g. paints, varnishes, solvents, batteries, fluorescent tubes, chemicals, etc.) can be handed in free of charge at a mobile pollutant collection point in all municipalities. Additional collections take place on 10 Saturdays in changing municipalities (dates in the calendar section). Used oil is not accepted, as the sales outlets are obliged to take back used oil in the quantity purchased. **Batteries and accumulators** must be taken back by the points of sale. In addition, battery

containers are available in town halls, schools and recycling yards.

Small quantities of pollutants from establishments

Small quantities of pollutants from painters, varnishers, plasterers, doctors, pharmacists, forestry offices, etc. can be disposed of at a charge by the company PreZero Service Süd GmbH after prior notification by telephone (07043-939-0).

Recycling yards

The Enzkreis operates recycling yards in Birkenfeld, Friolzheim, Ispringen, Keltern, Maulbronn, Mühlacker, Neulingen, Niefern, Königsbach, Straubenhardt and Wurmberg, which accept the following: Old clothes, old metal, old paper, aluminium, batteries, building rubble (small quantities), CDs, DVDs, small electrical appliances, windows, glass, wood, cardboard boxes, corks, plastic film, PU foam cans, edible fats and oils, bulky waste, polystyrene, toner cartridges, ink cartridges. Mineral and glass wool as well as materials containing asbestos can only be disposed at the disposal centre in Maulbronn (for a fee), as can TV sets, monitors and large electrical appliances (free of charge).

All used materials must be clean and the containers must be empty.

apartment buildings with advice.

Garden waste disposal

In the Enzkreis there are chipping sites for the free disposal of tree and shrub cuttings up to 15 cm in diameter, as well as grass cuttings, flower residues and other garden waste. However, compostable kitchen waste is not accepted; it belongs either in the organic waste bin or on the compost heap. It is important to separate woody tree and shrub cuttings from other garden waste.

Construction waste disposal

Mineral waste (roof tiles, masonry, etc.) can be recycled via the construction waste recycling plants of the companies EBRD in Bretten (Tel. 07252-77515) and BRP in Pforzheim – asphalt, concrete waste and natural stones only - (07231-52575).

Non-recyclable mineral waste such as gypsum, chimney stones or aerated concrete blocks belong to the disposal centre in Maulbronn or in small quantities to the recycling yards.
